

+ Why play junior hockey for the Boyanup Hockey Club?

Our club's purpose is to give each child an opportunity to reach their hockey potential. We cater from beginners to those seeking state representation.

+ I don't live in Boyanup - can I still play for the club?

Yes - We welcome players and families from all over the southwest. From Australind, Eaton, Dardanup, Boyanup, Dalyellup, Capel, Busselton and everywhere in between!

+ When does the season start and finish?

The season normally starts week 1 of term 2 and finishes by week 9 of term 3.

+ When and where are the games played?

J2, J3/4, J5/6 & J7/8s play on Saturday mornings. Some J2 & J3/4 games may be played on Friday nights. J9/12s play on Wednesday nights. All games are played at the Bunbury Hockey Stadium on Parade Road, either on turf or grass.

+ What junior grades are in the competition?

The Bunbury & Districts Hockey Association (BDJHA) has the following grades:

J2 - School years 2 and under (Mixed)

J3/4 - School years 3 & 4 (Mixed)

J5/6 - School years 5 & 6 (Separated into Boys & Girls)

J7/8 - School years 7 & 8 (Separated into Boys & Girls)

J9/12 - School years between 9 & 12 (Separated into Boys & Girls)

+ When equipment does the club provide?

The club provides playing shirts and goalie equipment for games. Balls, cones and other equipment required to practice and train are supplied.

We also have a range of sticks and shinpads we loan out - just ask!

+ What equipment does my child need to play?

A mouthguard, shinpads, hockey stick, and black shorts/skorts/skirts.

Boyanup socks are required and can be purchased for \$16 a pair. Shoes can be joggers or cross trainers, but football boots can't be worn on the turf

+ When and where is junior training?

J1/2s train in the first 30 minutes of their 1-hour game
Other grades will train on Tuesday afternoon - subject to turf availability at the Bunbury Hockey Stadium on Parade Road.

+ How much does it cost per season?

There are two (2) separate costs.

HA Levy - At the point of registration, a Hockey Australia levy is paid for all juniors, based on their age at 31/12/2023.

For juniors between 10 and 18 - a levy of \$42.50 is paid.

For juniors 9 and under - a levy of \$20 is paid.

Club fees - are paid later to the Club to cover turf hire, nomination costs and equipment. The 2023 fees have not been set, but the 2022 club fees were:

J1/2 - \$60, J3/4 - \$95, J5/6 - \$155, J7/8 - \$160, J9/12 - \$160

These fees will be confirmed and invoiced after round 1 of the season.

+ Are my kids insured?

If you have registered in 2023 through the Revolutionize platform and paid the Hockey Australia Levy (if applicable), you are insured. For more information on the insurance provided, visit <https://www.hockey.org.au/play/registration-and-insurance/>
